Purpose: The Community Oregon Expo is Part 3 of the Community Oregon Program Series and will feature Community Oregon participants who visited one another's communities for the Urban/Rural Exchange (Part 2) program which followed the Community Oregon Camp (Part 1) program in Camp Sherman.

Event Overview: Each Community Oregon individual participant or small group/team will make a presentation to the invited Community Oregon Expo audience about their Urban/Rural Community Exchange Experience.

Presentations should follow these guidelines:

- Presentations should last no longer than 5-7 minutes per person, or 15 minutes total per team
- If presenting as a team, each person in the group should have a speaking part in the presentation
- Presentations may include photos, music, video clips, etc.
- Participants will need to forward any audio-visuals to Healthy Democracy staff no later than 3 days prior to the event so they can be uploaded into the overall program files.

Audience: The Expo audience will be comprised of Community Oregon participant invitees (family members and special guests such as local elected officials – e.g. mayors/city councilors - business and non-profit leaders, etc.), and guests of Healthy Democracy such as state legislative representatives, members of Oregon's philanthropic community, and previous Community Oregon participants and partners.
