**Our Service Region:** Northern Colorado and southern and northeastern Wyoming - an area the side of Texas

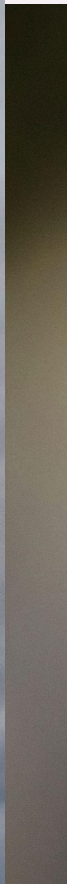
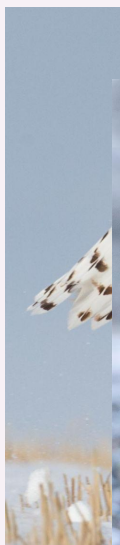

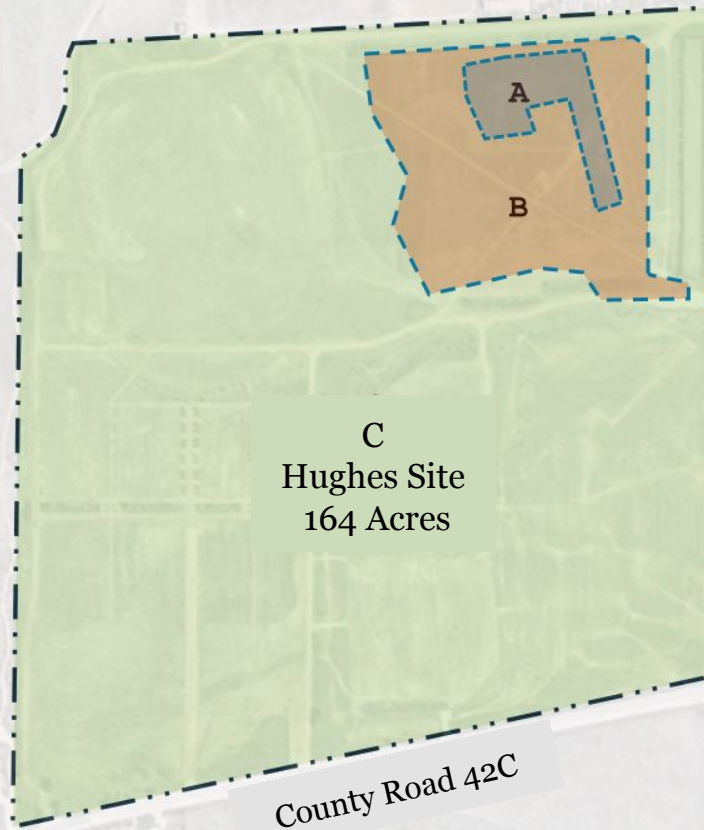
